Regulatory / Policymaker Roundtable: Can regulators keep pace 🧩 11:15 with the proliferation of new technologies and concepts?

InsurTechs are expected to fundamentally change the insurance industry in the next few years. Innovation is occurring in the insurance chain of value as technological advancements and consumer habits are evolving rapidly. InsurTechs offer simpler products that are more aligned with individual preference and consumer demand than the traditional insurance products.
